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
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Case for Support

We can advance patient care and dental education to best address West Virginia's oral health care needs.

Over 80% of the dentists practicing in West Virginia are graduates of our WVU School of Dentistry. We are also the first place West Virginians turn for comprehensive general dentistry and specialized treatment they either cannot afford or cannot access close to home.

Always driven to do what's best for our students and our state, we were among the first dental schools in the country to institute rural health rotations, sending students to gain hands-on experience in private practices and community clinics. We were the first school in the nation to offer an integrated dental hygiene bachelor's degree. We also are the only dental school with a program that trains providers as certified tobacco treatment specialists — a direct response to the needs of West Virginians.



Our School of Dentistry has embarked on an ambitious effort to secure first-class educational spaces and technology. Our Center for Dental Innovation is one of the most advanced training facilities of its kind in the eastern U.S. And WVU is one of a select number of dental schools nationwide with Yomi robotic-assisted technology for dental implant procedures.

Yet, we continue to treat patients and train the next generation of dentists and dental hygienists in outdated facilities. These clinical spaces have served as our WVU School of Dentistry's "front door" for over 15,000 West Virginians who come to us annually for their oral health needs. Our students, staff and faculty can be even more impactful in updated spaces designed to meet the needs of today's dental health professionals.

In partnership with one of the country's premier design firms for oral health care schools and facilities, we have developed a plan to renovate treatment areas focused on dental hygiene, oral and maxillofacial surgery, radiology, and pathology, pediatric dentistry, orthodontics, endodontics, periodontics and prosthodontics. Renovations are planned in two large phases:

- One phase will focus on pediatric dentistry, orthodontics, the Center for Dental Innovation and the Dental Group Practice.
- Another phase will focus on areas including a surgical suite, specialty clinics, and administrative and academic offices.

The result will be a school of dentistry transformed to meet 21st-century needs. Modernized facilities will radically enhance patient care and oral health care education for the next generation of WVU dentists and dental hygienists who, like you, aspire to make a difference. The new facilities will complement the mentoring and guidance provided by world-class faculty with expertise in unique specialties to ensure graduates are proficient in the most advanced techniques and evolving technologies.



Our School of Dentistry will go first and go far in meeting the oral health needs of all West Virginians, helping them live better, healthier lives.




















Naming Opportunities Pediatric Dentistry

We are upgrading and expanding our pediatric dental clinic to complement our residency program that helps meet oral health care needs for a growing number of Mountain State children. The expansion project will essentially double the existing treatment space to enhance care and education. Expansion means additional space for students, residents and faculty providers to administer care to younger and medically compromised patients. We continue to see an increase in the volume of pediatric patients who need emergency and comprehensive care. In collaboration with WVU Medicine, we will be able to provide same-day treatment options – especially for urgent and emergent needs. The renovation plans include quiet rooms for children with sensory issues and larger rooms designed to accommodate wheelchairs, specialized treatment equipment, caregiver assistance and more.



Naming Opportunities Center for Dental Innovation

The first phase of renovations in our School of Dentistry facilities plan will relocate the Center for Dental Innovation from its current Suncrest Towne Centre location back to the Health Sciences Campus. The distinct clinical training and treatment facility sets the standard for dentistry education in the United States and Canada. Through a partnership with the Center for Research and Education in Technology, our WVU School of Dentistry has access to the latest furnishings and patient care technology and materials from more than 30 product suppliers and manufacturing companies. Each fourth-year dental student spends a two-week rotation in the Center for Dental Innovation. Here, dental and dental hygiene students have multiple options allowing them to identify the best individualized treatment plan for their patients. An investment in this space creates opportunities for our students to engage in private practice experiences prior to completing their degree.



Naming Opportunities Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery

Construction of the new oral and maxillofacial surgery (OMFS) operatory suites will allow for better instruction of our residents and, more importantly, enhanced patient experiences. Providing care for conditions such as improper jaw alignment, oral cancer, sleep apnea, complex tooth extractions and complex facial reconstruction, OMFS is an integral part of the health care system of WVU Dental and WVU Medicine. Our students and faculty collaborate on patient referrals for cancer, cardiothoracic issues, reconstructive conditions and more.



Naming Opportunities Periodontics

Evidence of the connection between diabetes and periodontitis and the high number of diabetic patients in West Virginia prompted the development of our dental school's postdoctoral program. The growing demand for dental implants, interest in aesthetic procedures and treatment of disease necessitated a Master of Science program to prepare periodontists to meet those patient needs. In the clinic, providers have access to technology unique to dental schools like a state-of-the-art robotics system assisting providers and allowing even more precision during dental implant surgery. Scanners and 3D printers complement treatment plans addressing implant overdentures, bone augmentation, soft tissue grafts, and surgical and non-surgical treatment of periodontitis and peri-implantitis. Relocation of the clinic and its technological advancements will increase efficiency for student training and enhance patient assessment and treatment planning. An investment in the periodontics suite is an investment in the future of oral health in West Virginia.





